

- GOALS:
 - to bring substandard housing units into compliance with HUD's housing quality standards (including addressing lead-based paint hazards) and local building codes
 - o to provide safe, healthy housing
- Federal funding from HUD is awarded through THDA via a competitive state-wide process.
- Funding contains
 - o a 5-year forgiven compliance period for rehabs
 - o 15-year on reconstruction or mobile home replacement
- After a thorough inspection to compile a list of required work, all work is completed by licensed contractors.

HOME Program Application Overview

- Application for assistance is voluntary.
- Reside within the grant program boundaries
- Be owner and resident of the property for no less than one year
- Own only one property
- All property taxes are paid and up-to-date
- Obtain homeowner's insurance
- Have an unrestricted title
- Sign a Grant Note and a Deed of Trust
- Demonstrate an ability to maintain the residence repairs, safety concerns, health/cleanliness issues
- Have a place for temporary relocation if necessary
